Where are sports competitions being held?

All competitions will be held at the University of St. Thomas at 2115 Summit Ave, St. Paul, MN 55105. The Anderson Athletic & Recreation Complex will host aquatics, powerlifting and basketball, including individual skills, full-court & half-court. Some basketball games will be played at McCarthy Gym.

Where do delegations (teams) and volunteers register?

The registration area is located in Scooters on the first floor of the Anderson Student Center.

Where can I find an athlete or team?

Since we don't assign teams their own space, it isn't usually possible to pinpoint exactly where an athlete or team is located. Some teams will be camped out in the field house or hallway on the second floor of the Anderson Athletic & Recreation Complex. It is always best to know the athlete's delegation & team name if playing basketball and a cell phone number for the athlete's coach.

How can I find out what time an athlete is competing?

Ask for the master schedule (organized alphabetically by last name) at the information table, or check the basketball brackets in the main hallway in the Anderson Athletic & Recreation Complex.

When and where is lunch?

Lunch is served from 11 a.m.-2 p.m. Saturday and Sunday in The View cafeteria on the second floor of the Anderson Student Center. Lunch will only be served to registered participants. All registered athletes should receive meal tickets from their coaches. Friday's lunch will be from 11 a.m.-1 p.m. for Unified Basketball schools teams only.

When is dinner?

Dinner will be served on Saturday night in The View cafeteria from 4:30 – 7:30 p.m. for registered participants only. Friday's dinner will be from 4:30 p.m. – 7 p.m. for Unified Basketball teams only.

Where are awards being handed out?

Aquatics awards will be in the Tommie Room on the main floor of the Anderson Athletic & Recreation Center throughout the weekend. Powerlifting awards will be in the field house immediately following competition. Basketball skills awards will be in the field house immediately following competition. Full-court basketball team awards will be in the Woulfe Alumni Hall on the 3rd floor of the Anderson Student Center on Sunday. Half-court basketball team awards will be in Scooters on the main level of the Anderson Student Center on Sunday.

Where are the evening activities?

Entertainment will start at 6:30pm featuring music and the Timberwolves mascot Crunch. Celebration Ceremonies will follow at 7:30 p.m. with a DJ and dance to follow after ceremonies. All events are FREE to attend and will take place in the Schoenecker Arena in the Anderson Athletic and Recreation Complex.

Where can I buy food?

T's dining area will be open on the first floor of the Anderson Student Center. Concessions will also be sold throughout the weekend in the Anderson Athletic & Recreation Complex.

Where do I go if I have an emergency?

Please locate a Special Olympics Minnesota staff member, they'll be wearing a staff polo. You can also find one of the medical volunteers located in each building by the "Medical" sign.
