**Sport Specific Guidelines: Golf**

- All golfers or Unified Teams wishing to compete in the Traditional 9-Hole or Unified Alternate 9-Hole Shot Competitions must have participated in an Area Competition to obtain a qualifying score to be eligible for participation in the State Competition.
- In order for an athlete to participate in 9-hole unified alternate shot or traditional 9-hole competition, they must have completed an Individual Skills Test (at a competition) with a total score of at least 40 points in the past.
- Athletes may enter the Individual Skills Competition OR either 3-Hole Traditional, 9-Hole Traditional, 3-hole Unified Alternate Shot or 9-hole Unified Alternate Shot Competition, unless they need a score to qualify.
- No motorized golf carts will be allowed on the course except by course officials.
- Unified 3-hole and 9-hole teams must have competed together at an area competition in order to compete together at the state competition. No changes or substitutions to Unified 3-hole or 9-hole teams will be allowed between the area and state competitions.
- The maximum number of strokes per athlete or alternate shot team is 9 per hole.
