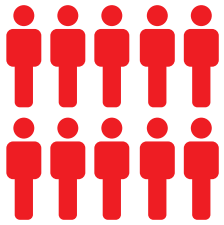

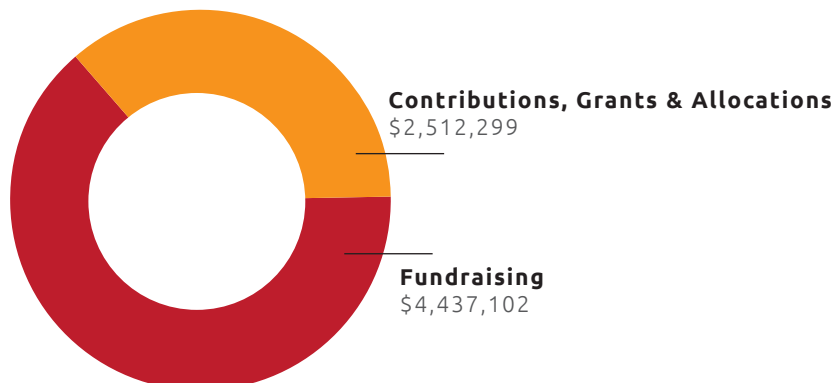

- Launch of Person First Campaign

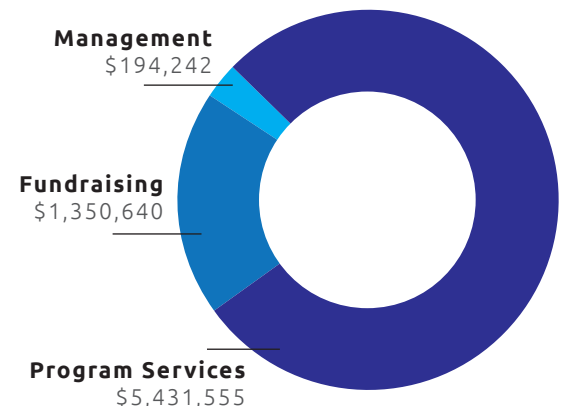
