2022 USA GAMES

The 2022 Special Olympics USA Games in Orlando, Florida united more than 5,500 athletes, Unified partners and coaches from all 50 states and the Caribbean. The Games offered 19 Olympic-style team and individual sports, and Special Olympics Minnesota sent its largest delegation in history. Over 150 athletes, Unified partners, coaches and staff represented Minnesota at the 2022 USA Games.

“Together we showcased the strength, resilience, kindness and talent of those that are a part of Special Olympics Minnesota,” said Kelly Monicatti, Vice President of Sports, Health & Schools. “Every person on the team made us proud to wear Minnesota colors!”

In May 2022, it was announced that Minnesota will host the 2026 Special Olympics USA Games. The Games will be held at the University of Minnesota and additional world-class venues throughout the Twin Cities metro area. The Games will be an incredible showcase of inclusion and competition, and are expected to bring over 115,000 people to Minnesota in June 2026.

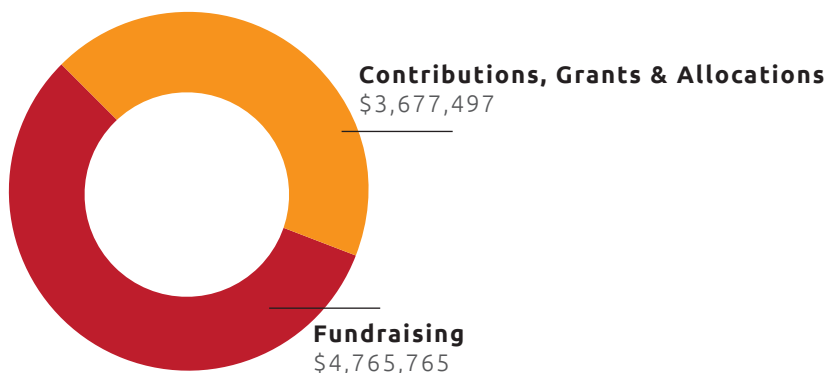
